- for example a field trip to Canmore and Banff allowed students to examine upstream water quality and a sewage treatment plant
- costs for this are higher than conventional classroom learning bus for the day is \$400
- · would like to see it used more in school
- pilot program with Grade 8 English students (alternative to Quebec trip?)
 - need to be able to say "this is the trip we want to take and this is what it will cost, who can afford it? Is corporate sponsorship possible?)
 - need to determine exactly how to roll out such a program
