- this is the last year for PATs (Provincial Achievement Tests)
 - PATs are good for determining how well the curriculum was taught through the year, but is a measurement after
 the fact
 - will be replaced with SLAs (Student Learner Assessments) which are written at the beginning of the year
 - · this allows teachers to understand what need to be done in the coming year

 - · a discussion of goals and outcomes ensued
 - "what does success for Manachaban Students look like?" was discussed
- · Nov 20 is the joint school council board meeting
- Thurs evening (Oct 20) is Doug Willims and Randall Fielding discussing Trends in Education at the Bert Church Theater
- · School for Fireside in Cochrane was announced for 2017
- · portable requests for Airdrie have been approved
- · Infrastructure and Maintenance Budget has been doubled for this year and next
- · Rockyview's FI students lag behind the provincial average needs work
 - · some facts which may or may not be relevant
 - · Francophone school results are aggregated into provincial FI results
 - all of Rockyview's FI schools are dual-track
