QUANTITY	ITEM DESCRIPTION- Outdoor Equipment List
1	*Sturdy pack that can be used for school books and as a daypack for field studies (with a waist belt.)
1	*Sturdy hiking shoes
1	*Clip board with cover (for writing during field studies – would like it to be able to "close")
1	*Rite in the Rain field journals (Ms. Pollard has some for \$8.50 each)
1	*Pencils with erasers (attached to clipboard with a string)
1	*Rain jacket
1	*Rain pants
1	Rain boots/bogs (optional but they are good for wet days and if canoe trip is wet and muddy- I wear mine all the time, and bogs are great for Bamfield if we get there next Spring)
1	WILD clothing equipment Warm winter jacket (weather proof)
1	Snow pants
2	Toque
3	Pairs Mitts (weather proof – snow repellant)
1	Gloves (thin layer for writing when cold)
3	Pair Wool socks (very important! No cotton for day trips or camps)
1	Long underwear (wool, polypro, silk, NOT COTTON
1	Pants that are not cotton (softshell, polypro) – see catalogue suggestions below
1	Sleeping bag (-10 rating at least)
1	Sleeping Pad (light weight, water-proof)
1	Headlamp or flashlight
1	Backpack (60 litres)— won't need a backpacking pack until May – can rent or borrow School supplies
