Dear Manachaban Families,

We have had an absolutely great start to this school year. Thank-you to everyone who came to our meet the teacher school orientation and to our students and staff who have been putting in great efforts getting everything in place and running smoothly. Below is some important information to keep you all in the loop.

NEW - Safe Arrivals

One of our greatest priorities is ensuring that all our students arrive safely to school every day. To improve our safe arrival process, we are adding a new system that will make it easier for you to report – and respond to – school absences of your student.

The new student absence reporting system will let you use a mobile app, a web site, or an interactive toll-free phone line to report an absence in advance. As a result, it will take the school less time to verify student attendance, and less time to begin to notify parents and guardians of absences that were unexpected or unplanned.

This time savings makes it faster and more efficient to account for all students and their safety.

If your student is marked absent and the absence hasn't been explained in advance, our new SafeArrival system will be able to rapidly contact you by automated phone call, text message, email, or mobile app push notification to get a reason for the absence. Calls and contacts will continue until you choose an option to explain the absence.

This new, automated SafeArrival process is part of our SchoolMessenger notification system from West, and our new SchoolMessenger mobile app for iOS and Android devices. It'll be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, to make it convenient for you to report future absences.

You'll soon be receiving more details on how to sign up for SafeArrival and we look forward to all families taking part.

RVS Assessment Plan

As part of RVS' plan to ensure that all our students can read, write and do math at appropriate levels, we are beginning a new assessment cycle at all schools across RVS. Depending on your child's grade, they will be taking part in brief benchmark assessments that give the teacher important information about the child's basic skills that can be used to guide instruction or to provide additional supports if needed. There is no preparation needed of your child for these assessments.

Your child's teachers can inform you at student led conferences about their progress and how we can work together to support their skill development. This information will not be shared as part of Real Time Reporting in PowerSchool nor is it used to determine their performance level in their grade. The purpose is to see where they are at in their basic skills and guide us on a path of improvement.

If you have specific questions about your child's assessments or learning in general, please reach out to your child's teacher.

Parental Involvement

There are many ways, beyond actually being in the school, that parents are involved in their child's school and education. Getting your child to school ready to learn is one of the most important ways you can support your child's education. All the forms you fill out, information meetings you attend, learning at home you support and communications you read from your child's teacher and the school are all ways you as a parent are involved. There are also many ways you can volunteer in and out of the school. We have sent a volunteer form home 2 weeks ago and will send a hard copy home as well for your convenience. Please send these back with the things you may want to volunteer with this year. You will require a Criminal record check with a vulnerable sector completed and on file to volunteer in the school and with students. If you do not have one yet and are applying you can still send in your volunteer form back and when you get your CVC you can email it to Mrs. Benoit at nbenoit@rockyview.ab.ca and she will upload it to the system. Please complete the yearly demographics forms and annual authorization forms and submit them before September 29th, 2022 if you have not already.

School Council

We will also have a link for those who want to join via Zoom for the meeting. All parents are welcome. We have a few positions to vote on and fill. Council Chair, Vice-Chair and Secretary/ Treasurer. We are also interested in finding someone to be the communications person and to have grade or classroom reps. Some of these positions are

indicated on the volunteer form. Please come out to council even if you do not want to fill a formal position. It's a great way to "have a voice and get your finger on the pulse of the school " (quoted from a new parent joining the school council).

Our council will be receiving a 500 dollar grant to support any initiatives that help parents get involved in their child's school and education. Last year we spent this grant on designing and printing the magnet calendars with important information about the school, dates and contact information. We are looking for feedback and ideas of how to utilize this school council money in the best way for our parents and students.
