## Principals Report:

- Interest based advisory - fairly successful
- Next year, look at a mixture of two existing programs
- Interest based Advisory - once every 2 weeks instead of every week. Have specific programs, science (scientist), LA (author), etc
- Will narrow down first 3 months over summer. Every 3-4 months new IBA.
- Next year timetable will reflect one core teacher for 5\&6.
- Character development - develop children of good character. Have people to talk to teachers about program. Early Aug. Sept program implemented.

- Grade 8 Farewell celebration - not graduation. \% of \$ from Dance a thon (collected from grade 8s) has been left with Gr. 8 teachers. Approx. $\$ 750.00$. Farewell committee has asked to use $\$ 750.00$ to offset farewell. Without money, cost would be $\$ 12.00$. If $\$ 750.00$ is contributed, it may be reduced by $\$ 5.00$.
- Teachers would like it spend on tree with plaque legacy from Gr. 8 kids. Either monument or educational tools would be better than on Farewell.
- MS will talk to grade 8 s to see what they would like.
- Farewell committee would like a portion of \$ to go to Gr. 8 Farewell.
