**NEW BUSINESS**

- Jeff Avery did a great job – he got donations from several companies.

- Motion made that council pay for than you ad in both papers. Possibly up to \$200 saying thank you to donators motioned by Dave Wilton, seconded by Sandra Iverson. Mike Summersgill will handle newspaper, Dave Levson will handle newsletter.
- Parent Volunteers were hard to find. Something to do for next year is to put it in the Volunteer form at the beginning of the year.
- Rocky View School charitable application. Manachaban did not apply. Mike Summersgill presented to all staff an on one came forward. Application was not put in. It is disappointing that money available was not asked for. There is some confusion as to where money can be used sometimes.
- Board of Trustees has decided the surplus funds would go into board's kitty, it will go towards scholarships. It will go to all 9 high schools.
- Dave Wilton suggests a copy be sent out to chairs. Colleen will make suggestions to Jackie Mirtel.

- Casino funds were \$42,997.07. Wish list provided by MS and Staff. Approximate costs indicates # of teachers that would incorporate into classrooms right away.
- DW thinks we should cover off 5 or 6 items to enhance learning for all kids.
- MS would like to see installation of speakers on gym wall. Estimate for \$2400.00. That is on priority. Another are smart boards & LCD TVs.
- There is a mix of English and French Teachers & grade levels.
- We want to impact as many students as possible.
- Everything on the list totals \$41,950.00.
- Once Mike Summersgill gets go ahead, he will order.
