Welcome and Intros

Additions to the agenda: Terry White & Active Living Day. Agenda then passed by consent. Minutes from previous meeting adopted

Financial Report

- Balance is still \$2736.21
- need another person with signing authority so that cheques can be signed Stephen and Marla do this
- still expecting a cheque from the walkathon for ~\$7000

Staff Report

- · dance went well
- Spelling Bee will be held on Thursday (Jan 12) each class has one or two representatives (but not all class are participating)
- Dec 23 was a Community of Practice day for the teachers
- Active Living Day is coming up March 5
 - Terry is requesting \$8.50 per student from School Council to defray costs (this is a standard yearly request)
 - · This amount usually covers bussing
 - usually there are around 20 students participating in the 'free' activity this year it is bowling and the money will cover the bowling fee and a small snack
 - · most expensive activity is skiing (at \$61)
 - Motion was made by Sara to give \$3850 (\$8.50 x 550 students (plus or minus one)) for active living day, seconded by Sigi - passed

Admin Report

- breakfast program is back although the funding has changed
- · new funding has allowed the hiring of a new teaching assistant full time until the end of June
- Excellence in Teaching Award nomination deadline is Feb 3
- · Grade 8 hallway privilege is starting to be taken for granted
 - garbage is being left in the hallway, the table is being abused
 - they have been threatened with a return to the gym for lunch where their movements are far more restricted
 - · this seems to have improved things for now
 - · maybe just the trouble makers need to be put into the gym
- Kool Kids grades 5 & 6 Canadian Liver Foundation has a 6 week educational program representative from the classes attend and then report back

- · Mrs Greaves is an instructor for Gord Neufeld's programs two have been presented so far
 - there is an 8 week program on offer (\$40/couple or \$25/person) 2 hours per week
 - healthy relationship program for grades 5 & 6 for 7 weeks offered in partnership with the Boys and Girls
- Feb 29th is Pink Shirt Day to promote healthy relationships t-shirts are being ordered \$5 each
- First Aid training should have 6 on staff had 4 and now 2 are expired
 - · next PD day will be first aid training for half the staff
- Portable Defibrillators school does not have one but there may be a couple of kids at school where this could be an issue
 - need to talk to Rockyview to discuss training and maintenance
 - cost is approx \$2000 (8 years of battery life)
 - looking to split the cost with School Council
 - Council must defer until we have the walkathon money and know our balance exactly (esp since we just voted to spend \$3850)
 - · Thomas will buy anyway and see about council contributing later
 - · Bow Valley High School had theirs donated
 - Mark Kondro (was on Manachaban Council last year) had strong opinions on this he may be a good person to talk to
- · Grade 8 Farewell need to start working on it get parents involved

Trustee Report

- · Thursday is the next board meeting
- In December a two year extension to the Edge School Pilot was approved
 - · Edge school has opted to dissolve the partnership and will revert to a private school in September
- Elizabeth Barrett Manachaban Review committee no word yet, but it should be starting soon
- Provincially Boards and teachers and province are looking at the teacher labour contracts (which expire at the end of August) lots of work is going on behind the scenes
- · Colleen will look at the board policy regarding medical devices
- · Last month a comment was made that the government model with regard to trustees and boards could change
 - · a bit of clarification
 - · provincial government is working on a new education act
 - · the last time school boards were amalgamated was 1994
 - Calgary Board of Education has 9 trustees for 300,000 students
