Trustee Report

- Capital expenditure of \$860,000 approved to improve school parking lots at Chestermere High School (current one too small) and Elbow Valley (too many holes)
 - money is from cash-in-lieu [of land] from developers
- Rockyview will service students in the annexed [into Calgary] area of Springbank
- Portables Board decided to use portables at Prince of Peace in Chestermere
 - · Airdrie Council of Councils has asked the board to rescind the motion and use them in Airdrie instead
 - also asking for clarification from Alberta if there has been a breach of the school act for taking out of area students at Prince of Peace (approx 40% are from Calgary) (should not take out of area students if school over 85% full)
- · after provincial election, Rockyview has one PC and three Wildrose MLAs in its bounds

Admin Report

- · RVS Satisfaction Survey is running from May 7 to 28 for students and staff, and until June 11 for parents
- On the evening of June 5th the Grade 6s will have the opportunity to watch the Transit of Venus at the acreage
