Treasurer Report

- currently have \$10,836.45

 - approx \$4000 for buses for active living day still to come out

Admin Report

- · looking at implementing a "balanced day" next year
 - Mon-Thurs there would be three blocks of 110 minutes each, broken up by a 25 min break from 10:55-11:20, and a 30 min break from 1:10-1:40
 - Fri would see three blocks of 73 minutes each, broken up by a 25 min break from 10:08-10:33, and a 30 min break from 11:46-12:16
 - this allows kids a longer morning break to eat a substantial snack and have some time outside current day has only a ten minutes morning break and a longer lunch break, but lunch is quite late
 - · there will no longer be restrictions on where kids eat
 - could make Friday a longer lunch (since the day is short) to allow the older kids longer to go down the hill to buy their lunch
 - · shorter lunch time still leaves time for hot lunches
 - 110 minute block seems long, but is effectively what is in place now (especially since some subjects are double blocked
 - · teachers have the ability to break up subject time as they see fit
 - will make project based learning easier
- Quest Theater
 - will be at school late April/early May
 - · 36 students register
 - Mount Royal Financial Literacy trip is in conflict
- Staffing
 - Mme Arsenault will be returning
- Career and Technology Foundation (CTF) new curriculum to be implemented
 - Five areas of focus
 - Business
 - Human Services
 - Technology (not just digital includes fabrication, construction, etc)
 - Resources
 - Communication (fashion and design falls here)
 - · apply these to existing options good coverage already

- Renovations
 - have \$150,000
 - will add more glass doors between classrooms
 - work can start on Monday
 - try not to be disruptive
 - summer doesn't really work for renovations because workers are often busy installing portable classrooms
 - see how far money goes would also like:
 - · a wall built in the shop space to accommodate tool storage
 - to redo art room add sinks, put in new cupboards and use it for science as well
- new teacher, Joshua Lafleur, has been nominated for Edwin Parr award (given to 1st year teachers)
- term 3 starts today
- grade 8 grad
 - · looks like it will be a trip to the Wild Rapids Waterslide in Sylvan Lake

Trustee Report

- just had the grand opening for three new schools in Airdrie and Chestermere
 - CW Perry had a flash mob lots of fun
- March 5 School Board Meeting
 - prioritized a budget in anticipation of provincial budget on Mar 26
 - · focus is on learners classroom instruction, special needs, numeracy, literacy
- March 11 School Board Meeting
 - approved instructional fees at \$115 (no increase)
 - transportation fees are yet to come can either raise fees \$110 per family or use reserve monies
 each bus route is approx \$50,000
- working on the Capital Plan
 - New Schools for Fireside and Airdrie have been announced, but have not yet been funded may have to put
 them back on the capital plan
- · working on consolidating policies
 - currently have 127 many are legacy
- attendance area for new school in Sunset Ridge opening Fall 2016
 - · initial consultation with parents has happened
 - · scenarios will be worked on and then presented to the public
 - · final decision in June
