Things to know:

- Youth ages 12-17 can be charged under YCJA

- Students may be posting inappropriate images and not understand they are permanent when put on the internet and not understand the consequences, and they may be used against them for bullying

- Nothing posted online is anonymous

- Students should not share personal information such as address, name of school, phone number or passwords over the chats on the internet

- Although the students may have the phone, the account is under than parents as phone accounts cannot be given to anyone under the age of 18, therefore parents are responsible for what is being put on the internet by their youth
